



Property Stewardship Team Member Volunteer Position

Title: Stewardship Team Member

Purpose:

We are looking to establish a stewardship team for each property which will consist of a team leader and a number of members. Teams will visit their assigned property at least once a month and additional work days will be convened as needed. Team members will stay in communication with their team leader who will notify them of any work days, visits, or meetings. No special skills are required, and any necessary training will be provided.

Key Responsibilities:

- Participate in monitoring under the guidance of the Team Leader & the Stewardship Coordinator
- Assist as needed with remedial work
- Participate in on-going training and education opportunities
- Act as the “eyes and ears” for a property and report any concerns to the Team Leader
- Pass along any ideas for new projects or tasks for the property to Team Leader

Length of position: Six months is required.

Expected time commitment: April-November, 2 hours a month minimum

- Computer, Internet access and email preferred
