Long Point Basin Land Trust is pleased to offer five properties available for deer and turkey hunting in 2024. Hunters play an important role in conservation by managing certain animal populations. This application includes questions about your past hunting experience on our properties, if any. The information is important to our organization as it helps us understand what properties are being overharvested and allows us to take the necessary action to maintain hunting opportunities for all.

Important Information:

- It can take up to 15 days for Long Point Basin Land Trust to process your application and send out the permission form though we try our best to get them out as quickly as possible. If you have not received your permission form within 15 days, please check your email spam folder. You may not hunt on our properties until you receive your permission form and you must carry it with you at all times while on Long Point Basin Land Trust property.
- Every hunter, even if you are planning to hunt in a group, must apply individually for permission to hunt on Long Point Basin Land Trust properties.

Terms and Conditions of Access to Long Point Basin Land Trust Properties

1. The applicant must carry their permit at all times while on Long Point Basin Land Trust property.
2. Vehicles must be parked in the designated parking areas. The vehicle identification form that you will receive with your permit must be clearly visible on the dashboard of the vehicle.
3. No overnight parking is permitted.
4. The Applicant will only hunt and retrieve game within the areas of permitted access.
5. The only species available for hunting on Long Point Basin Land Trust properties are white-tailed deer and wild turkey. Hunting of waterfowl is not permitted.
6. The area must be left in a clean and undamaged condition.
7. Only portable tree stands and blinds are permitted and shall be removed from the property at the end of the Applicant's hunt.
8. The Applicant shall abide by all federal, provincial, and municipal laws regulating hunting activities while on Long Point Basin Land Trust property.

The Following are Prohibited Activities on Long Point Basin Land Trust Properties

1. Access by any motorized vehicle (e.g., ATV, 4X4 truck).
2. Construction or erection of any paths, trails, bridges, permanent tree stands and blinds, shelters, cabins, barricades, structures.
3. Alteration of topography.
4. Cutting dead or living vegetation.
5. Lighting fires.
6. Gathering or planting vegetation.
7. Overnight stays and overnight parking.
