Hunters play an important role in conservation by managing certain wildlife populations. This application includes questions about your past hunting experience on our properties, if any, to help us determine the overall hunting pressure on each site.

Important Information:

- It can take up to **15 days** for Long Point Basin Land Trust to process your application and send your permission form, although we work to process applications as quickly as possible.
- You **may not hunt** on our properties until you receive your permission form, and you must **carry it with you at all times** while on Long Point Basin Land Trust property.
- Every hunter, **even if part of a group**, must apply individually for permission to hunt on Long Point Basin Land Trust properties.

Terms and Conditions of Access to Long Point Basin Land Trust Properties:

1. The Applicant must carry this Permission Form at all times while on Long Point Basin Land Trust property.
2. Vehicles must be parked in the designated parking area. The vehicle identification form must be clearly visible on the dashboard.
3. No overnight parking is permitted.
4. The Applicant will hunt and retrieve game only within the areas of permitted access as shown on the map(s) provided with the Permission Form.
5. Only white-tailed deer and wild turkey may be hunted. Hunting waterfowl is not permitted.
6. The area must be left in a clean and undamaged condition.
7. Only portable tree stands and blinds are permitted and must be removed at the end of each hunt.
8. The Applicant must abide by all federal, provincial, and municipal hunting laws and regulations.
9. A 100 m buffer zone must be respected on the west side of Trout Creek Nature Reserve. 'No Hunting Beyond This Point' signs are posted along the north/south trail, which serves as a visual barrier.

The Following are Prohibited Activities on Long Point Basin Land Trust Properties

1. Access by any motorized vehicle.
2. Construction or erection of paths, trails, bridges, permanent stands or blinds, shelters, cabins, barricades, or structures.
3. Alteration of topography.
4. Cutting dead or living vegetation.
5. Lighting fires.
6. Gathering or planting vegetation.
7. Overnight stays and overnight parking.
